International EUREM consortium – headed by Industrial Chamber Nuernberg, Germany – monitors quality standards and develops the training further





Responsible for implementation is the Competence Centre Sustainable Energy of the Southern African German Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SAGCC)


**Training locations** are **Johannesburg and Cape Town** - one training annually per location. Training in Durban will start in 2015.

## TRAINING STRUCTURE



#### Lectures

9 modules with classroom lessons, 120 hours in total – possibility for self-study via e-Forum

Transfer of theoretic knowledge, introduction to new technology and processes, exercises and discussion


