Problem

- Organic and C&D waste large portion of our waste.
- Limited landfill airspace.
- Illegal dumping large portions of C&D waste.
- They have an environmental impact at every step of the building process;
 - extraction of raw materials,
 - processing,
 - manufacturing,
 - transportation,
 - construction and disposal at the end of a building's useful life.





- Building materials account for about half of all materials used and about half the solid waste generated worldwide.
- CoCT C&DW comprises 10% by volume & 22% by mass to landfill.





- Engage diverse stakeholders discuss the problem and to develop unified action plan to divert C&DW from landfills.
- Identify opportunities for business and industry to invest in activities that will create profit and improve environmental outcomes by extracting valuable recourses from the C&DW.
- Stimulate the re-use and recycling of C&DW
