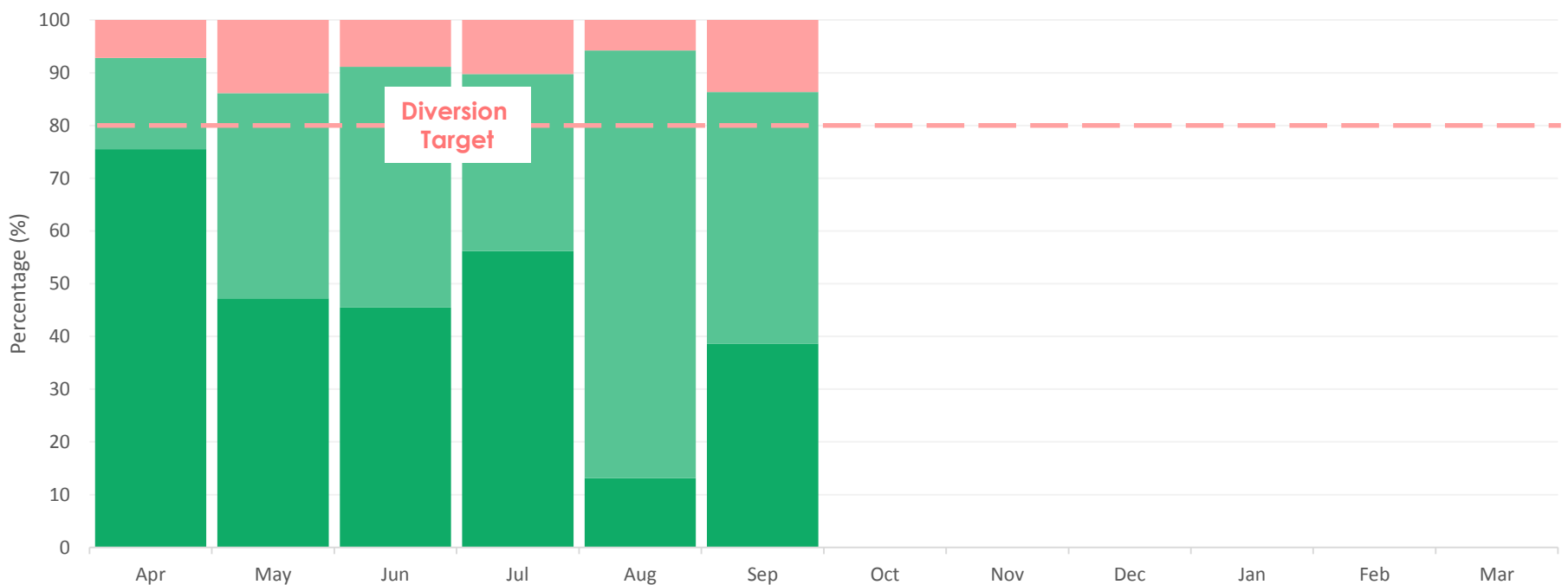
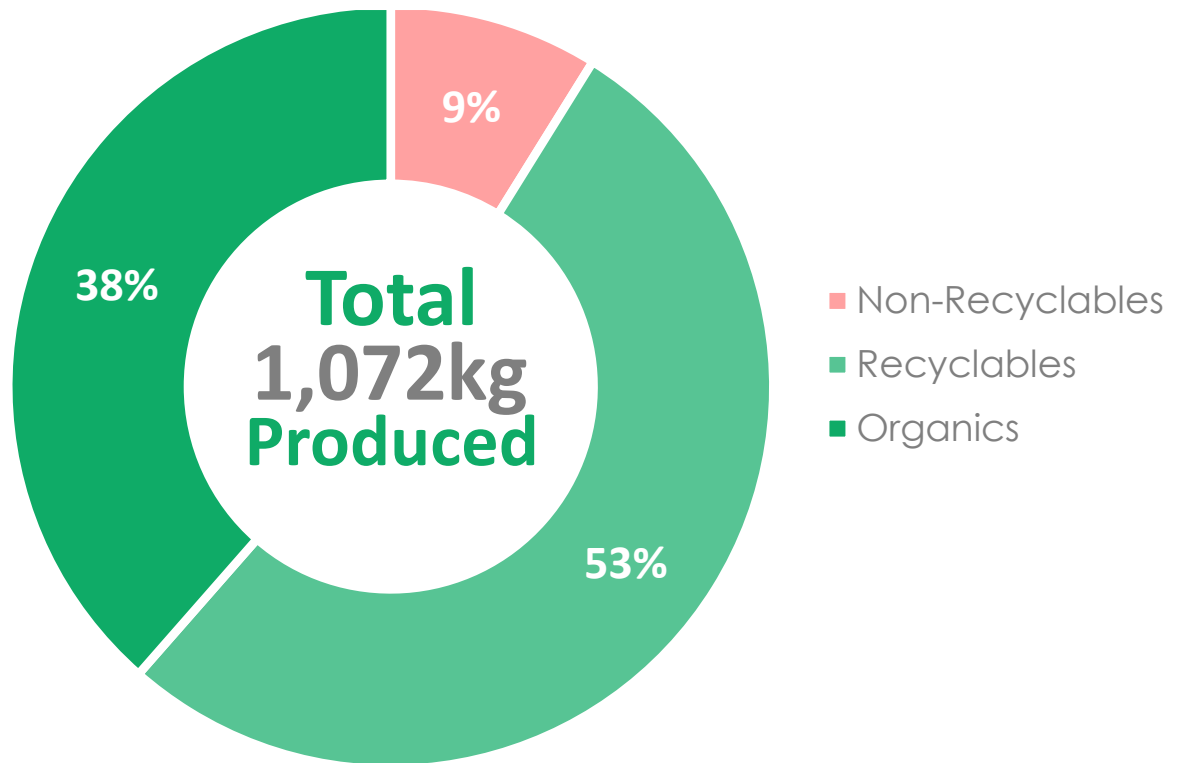


Waste@Work

2018/2019: Apr – Sep



Six months into the 2018/19 financial year, and GreenCape continues to hit above its 80% diversion target. So far this year, we have generated 1,072kgs of waste. This is 323 kgs more than the first six months of 2017/18 which showed 749kgs accumulated. A bulk of the increase can be attributed the “August office document purge” which resulted in roughly 278kgs of paper/cardboard being diverted. Of total waste thus far, 413kg was organics (38%), 564kgs (53%) were recyclables, and the remaining 95kgs (9%) was sent to landfill. September also marks the month of the year that GreenCape hit the one tonne waste generation mark. In 2017/18 this mark was hit only in November 2017. Nevertheless, we continue to shift waste from landfill to companies adding value to our waste. Thank you all for your continual effort to reduce our office’s impact not only on the environment, but also on our city’s infrastructure.
